Race Day Fact Sheet

- Race Time:** 5k and 1 mile events start together at 8:00 a.m.
- Survivor Recognition:** Program begins at 7 a.m. at the main stage. Survivor Photo and Jazzercise warm up to follow.
- Location:** Starting line is in front of the i wireless Center in downtown Moline, Illinois; route goes through Moline and Rock Island, returning to the i wireless Center
- Parking/Shuttle:** Limited parking for survivors with pink bib numbers is available until 6:45 a.m. in the i wireless Center parking lot. On-street parking can be found in downtown Moline, off the Race route. Shuttles will run between the QC Expo Center, 2621 4th Avenue in Rock Island and Centre Station in Moline, beginning at 6:30 a.m. Last shuttle will leave the Race area at approximately 10 a.m.
- Team Meeting Spot:** **New this year!** Meet your teammates in the parking lot of the American Red Cross of the Quad Cities Area at 1100 River Drive, Moline, across from the i wireless center parking lot, so you can line up and start the Race together. (There won't be any events going on there; it's just a convenient place to meet, and we thank the Red Cross for making it available!)
- Timing:** The Race will not be timed this year. Money previously spent on a formal timing system will be used to fight breast cancer. Each participant will be responsible for timing themselves. Visual timing clocks will be available at the finish line.
- Strollers, etc:** Strollers, wagons, wheelchairs and service animals are welcome; please line up toward the rear to allow runners and faster walkers the right of way. No bicycles, skates, skateboards, rollerblades or pets, please.
- Awards:** Team awards will be presented following the Race at the stage area in the i wireless Center parking lot. Please visit the exhibitor booths in the parking lot before or after the Race for goodies and good information.
